Theatrical and film songs (a mix of published and unpublished) and advertising jingles are listed separately for ease of genre reference.</p>					<p>Allan's Music Publishing, EMI Allans, EMI Davis and EMI Music Publishing Aust. are now owned by Sony Music Publishing (Australia), publisher and worldwide copyright owner of most Jack O'Hagan's songs. Many O'Hagan songs published by Jack O'Hagan Music in the early 1930s belong to the Jack O'Hagan Estate. Songs where Jack adapted the lyrics of international songs for local use or contributed music or lyrics for another composer's work were sometimes purchased outright by Allan's and are included here. In most cases, song titles that commence with 'A' or 'The' have had those words removed, as per industry catalogues. Known unpublished songs (excluding unpublished theatre/film songs and advertising jingles) have been included and belong to the Jack O'Hagan Estate. Jack wrote and played by ear and had his music transcribed by others. It could be assumed that Jack had music in mind for the Unpublished Lyrics listed at the end of this document but transcriptions have not been found.
