Songs where Jack adapted the lyrics of international songs for local use or contributed music or lyrics for another composer's work were sometimes purchased outright by Allan's and are included here. In most cases, song titles that commence with 'A' or 'The' have had those words removed, as per industry catalogues.			Jack received royalties from all over the world.
